History and Significance of Ganesh Chaturthi

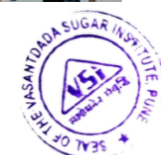
Lord Ganesha, the god of wisdom, knowledge, prosperity, and happiness, has a fascinating origin story. According to legend, Maa Parvati created Lord Ganesha from sandalwood paste and instructed him to guard her while she bathed. When Lord Shiva returned and attempted to enter, an unaware Ganesha denied him entry, leading to a conflict. In anger, Lord Shiva severed Ganesha's head.

To calm the furious Maa Parvati, Lord Shiva replaced Ganesha's head with that of a baby elephant, granting him life again and making him the elephant-headed god.

Objectives of Ganesh Chaturthi Celebrations

1. To honor Lord Ganesha as the God of New Beginnings and the Remover of Obstacles.
2. To inspire future generations by maintaining and promoting cultural traditions.
3. To celebrate wisdom, intelligence, and prosperity through rituals and festivities.
